Considerations

AIDA was a very special project to manage. There were many areas of sensitivity that we needed to be aware of.

Significant effort was made to transform the venue to create a welcoming space. Some of the touches included

- Gathering areas, with indigenous printed floor rugs
- The scent of gum leaves and native flowers throughout the venue
- Quiet rooms for anyone needing a break

- Breathwork and Meditation classes held at the refreshment times
- Plenary overflow area, to allow people to watch proceedings, but be away from the main room
- A dedicated student sitting area, a safe gathering space
- Five welcome to country ceremonies throughout the event

With these initiatives and others we were able to achieve a very welcoming collegial environment for the indigenous doctors.
